Studio Etiquette Grade

Respecting the studio space, materials, instructor, and your peers is important. When some students disrespect the studio, the class atmosphere eventually become negative and everyone's enjoyment of the class suffers. Therefore for every project, you will receive an "Effort/Participation" grade (studio etiquette grade) worth 25 points. Certain infractions upon studio etiquette will cost you -.5 points. These infractions will be tracked on a day to day basis. Some of these infractions include the following:

- Phones are out when demonstrating or introducing a lesson and I ask you to put them away
- Using your phone for texting, pictures, social media, video games, etc
- Distracting behaviors or bothering other students
- Calling out, making noise, or distracting others during a demonstration
- Doing nothing (if you are done, ask if there is anything else you can work on)
- Not cleaning up your space
- Wasting or Misusing materials
- Fooling around during clean up
- Leaving your artwork/folder/tools etc in places other than where they belong
- Making fun of other students work

You can earn back points for doing things that improve the studio atmosphere such as:

- Helping to clean up something that is not yours
- Volunteering to clean up or hand out materials/artwork
- Helping to organize something in the classroom
- Volunteering to prep for an art show

***Remember...music is allowed in class when it's <u>independent work time</u>. No phones should be out during demonstration or instruction time. Phones may not be used for photography, video taping, social media, texting, etc. Anything not related to the class.
